This annual event is free and open to the public BUT RSVPs are required as seating is limited. The event is expected to reach maximum capacity.

The Business Summit will include an annual State of the City address by the Mayor of the City of Chico, Sean Morgan. Other presentations include: a Business Climate Report from Chair of the Chamber Board of Directors, Anastacia Snyder with Catalyst Domestic Violence Services; a Chico Economic Snapshot for 2018 delivered by Mark Francis with Golden Valley Bank; and a Downtown Report presented by Melanie Bassett with the Downtown Chico Business Association.
